

NDOT Emergency Repairs – Khalil Jaber



Deputy Director Khalil Jaber will give an overview of the Nebraska Department of Transportation's (NDOT) response to the historic and devastating March 2019 flooding. State Damages include 27 bridges and ~200 miles of pavement totaling ~\$130M.

Khalil Jaber was appointed the Deputy Director – Engineering for NDOT in August of 2012. Prior to that, he was the Program Management Engineer, the Public Transportation Engineer in the Rail and Transit Sections, a Project Engineer and Consultant Coordinator in Roadway Design, and a field Project Manager in District Five, Bridgeport Office. He has a B.S. in Civil Engineering from Kansas State University, and is a Registered Professional Engineer and a Project Management Professional. Khalil is married and has two children.
